

ARTICLE XV

Admission

Section 1. All applications for admission to the Home must be filed with the Board of Directors who refer the same to the Investigating Committee for further investigation. All applications must be filed on the official blanks furnished by the Home.

Sec. 2. Any applicant who is admitted as a result of false or incorrect information about his or her age, or financial circumstances of himself, herself, or family, may be expelled from the Home by the Board of Directors.

Sec. 3. Every applicant must be examined by the Physician of the Home, a written examination report must be filed with the Board of Directors, stating his or her condition of health. Applicants with contagious or mental diseases must never be admitted.

Sec. 4. Applicants for the Home must be at least sixty years of age. When applicants have some income or expect any inheritance after their death, such cases should be regulated by written special agreement.

ARTICLE XVI

Section 1. The Director shall have in his charge the management of the Home, and shall always be under the direction of the Board of Directors. His duty shall be to purchase all supplies requested of him by the Board of Directors.

Sec. 2. In making his budget and conducting the Home, he shall work in cooperation with the House Committee.

Sec. 3. He shall make reports concerning the expenses and activities and happenings at the Home at each Board Meeting.
