

service and extension departments. Each participating school presents a unit in an integrated musical program designed to develop within the children an appreciation of Jewish music, and through that music, to give expression to the joy and beauty of Jewish living.

OPERATION OF THE BUREAU NURSERY SCHOOL. The Bureau maintains a model Jewish Nursery School and thus conditions the very young children favorably for Jewish training in the schools which they will enter at a later age.

New services to schools are projected for the near future, and it is hoped that the funds for the implementation of these projects will be forthcoming.

SERVICES TO YOUTH GROUPS

The extension department of the Bureau offers and renders the following services to youth clubs and organizations:

PROGRAMMING. The extension director assists youth groups in arranging suitable programs for every occasion as well as for the entire year, stressing Jewish content at all times.

CONSULTATION. Youth groups receive the expert advice of the Bureau's extension department on how to develop effective organizational techniques; on how to stimulate greater interest and wider participation of the membership in various projects and activities of the group; on how to improve the conduct of meetings, etc.

SPEAKERS' BUREAU. Speakers and discussion leaders are provided by the Bureau to youth clubs for various occasions.

YOUTH LEADERS' TRAINING INSTITUTE. This is a seminar of five to eight weekly sessions, sponsored jointly by the Bureau of Jewish Education and the Jewish Center, and designed to acquaint potential youth leaders with basic group work techniques and with the Jewish aspect of programming for youth clubs.

YOUTH CHORAL AND DANCE GROUP. Organized by the Bureau in cooperation with youth organizations in the community. This group used to present the Shavuot Festival. Beginning with 1950, it plans to hold annually a gay and colorful Purim Festival instead.

SERVING THE COMMUNITY TOGETHER—A conference between the staffs of the Bureau of Jewish Education and the Jewish Center on joint community-wide projects.
