



*Top to bottom: Recess fun. Pre-primary students study "Sam" the anatomy model. At the Model Seder.*

Yeshiva Chofetz Chaim and Kindergarten was founded in 1946 through the interests of Rabbi Eliezer Silver, z"tl, representatives of the Vaad Hoier and The Orthodox Synagogues, and representatives of the Talmud Torah. The day school received its charter in the spring of 1947. The first classes began in the Young Israel building at 610 Forest Avenue. In September of 1949, Chofetz Chaim moved to its own home at 3669 Reading Road, which was occupied until June 1963. While a new building was being completed in the fall of 1963, Ohav Shalom Synagogue generously supplied classroom space. Finally, through the dedicated efforts of our Board of Directors, the Cincinnati Hebrew Day School moved to its present modern quarters in January of 1964.
