

SYNAGOG SELECTS NEW RABBI



Rabbi David I. Indich
The Forest Ave. Synagogue, 521 Forest Avenue, has selected Rabbi David I. Indich as its Rabbi, it was announced by President Saul Waxler, at the last meeting of the Congregation.

Rabbi Indich was educated in New York City Public Schools, and attended Brooklyn College. He also attended Mesivta Talmudical Seminary, and was ordained at the Rabbinical College of Telshe, Cleveland, Ohio.

Before coming to Cincinnati, Rabbi Indich was the Executive Secretary of an Israeli organization, and lecturing on Jewish Education. He was extremely active in Agudath Israel, Young Israel, and in many other fields of Jewish endeavors.

Rabbi Indich is single but plans to return to New York in early summer to marry and bring his new bride back to Cincinnati.

At present, the Rabbi is officiating at Daily morning and Evening Services and can be contacted at his office and Study, located in the Synagogue Annex at 3550 Washington Avenue.

Plans for an official Installation of Rabbi Indich are being made for this summer.
