

**MEDICINES DURING PASSOVER**  
**The Contents of Drugs and**  
**The Dinim of Pesach**  
**Prepared by Raoul B. Nass, M.D.**

In order to aid rabbis, physicians and others interested in the question, the following information concerning the Pesach status of various drugs has been prepared. This listing is not intended to "paskenen shailos" (for which an Orthodox Rabbi must be consulted) but only to make available certain basic information concerning the composition of various drug products. In every case, the condition of the patient, nature of the illness and type of the drug must be considered. This should be done by a illness and type of the drug must be considered. This should be done by a consultation of the rabbi and the physician.

Drugs can be divided into various general classifications depending on their physical properties, and medical nature.

The following drugs are permissible on the holiday of Pesach, provided that a new box or package is used.

The following drugs are not used on the holiday of Pesach:

Horseradish (there are many questions about bought horseradish, ask your Rabbi for consultation.)

Asparagus, Brocoli, Cauliflower, Mushrooms, Wax Paper, can be used if they are wrapped, and were never exposed to any chometz.

Concerning Garlic, this depends on custom; some Jews in Russia and Lithuania used it, others do not use it.

Mustard can be used for baths only (externally).

Carnation Milk can be used for babies.

(If any of above fruits or vegetables were cut, trimmed or treated, then an Orthodox Rabbi should be consulted.)

The following foods are forbidden on Pesach:
