The piece "ato hu elokeinu" is not said; the siluk is omitted.

The baal t'kiah should get an aliye on the first day, on shabos on the 2nd day.

Before the blowing of the shofar the congregation says seven times "l'omnazeach" (Psalm 47). It is wrong to say "boruch hu uvoruch shmo" for the brochos of the baal t'kiah. It is against the Jewish law to talk from the first brochoh until after the last t'kiah (but how many care?) The "yehi rozon" between the t'kiah are for the baal t'kiah only!

The Musaf chasan repeats loud "l'olom uolimei olmayo" in his kadish. "Omez adirei" (before "melech olyon" is omitted. "Ein kizvoh" and "kesod siach" is sung by the choir resp. congregants. The interpolations in the Kedusho are omitted. "Tusgaw lewadecho" after "wechol
