**Note:** To read correctly the Hebrew prayers in English letters, pronounce every **a** like in **far**; **e** like in **bed**; **i** like in **pin**; **o** like in **for**; **u** like in **full**; **ay** like in **day**; **ow** like in **show**; **y** at the end of words like in **by**; **ch** like in German **doch**. A vowel followed by an apostrophe is to be joined with the next syllabe into one (Vocal Sheva).
