

Sec. 8. A vote on the admission of applicant or the expenditure of money exceeding \$500.00, must have at least two-thirds majority vote of those present.

Sec. 9. A member of the Board who, without good excuse, is absent from six regular meetings of the Board, may be dropped from the membership of the Board of Directors.

Sec. 10. At the first regular meeting of the Board, after the annual meeting of the members, the Board shall elect its officers. Any vacancies in the office of the President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Recording Secretary or Financial Secretary, occurring after their election as such, shall be filled by the Board at the next regular meeting of the Board after such vacancy.

ARTICLE VI

Duties of the President

Section 1. The president shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors, appoint all committees, unless specially provided for by the Constitution.

Sec. 2. The President is authorized to perform all duties usually performed by Presidents and any other duty the Board of Directors may assign to him. In his absence, the First Vice-President shall assume the duties of the President, and if President and the Vice-President are absent, the Second Vice-President shall assume the duties.

Sec. 3. The Executive Committee shall be the custodian of all properties of this institution, and shall act as its Board of Trustees.

Sec. 4. The Honorary President shall perform any duty assigned to him by the Board of Directors.
