THE PRE-SEDER PARTY. This is an annual community pre-Passover celebration of great popular appeal, richly expressive of the spirit of the Festival of Freedom. A modern Haggadah, written for the occasion by Charles S. Becker, is read with audience participation. There is a great deal of community singing, and an appropriate dramatic presentation completes the delightful program. Passover refreshments are served.

The Pre-Seder Party, initiated in 1934, has by now assumed the character of a true folk festival.
