HEBREW SCHOLAR TO ADDRESS ANNUAL BANQUET
Dr. Abraham S. Halkin, noted Hebrew scholar and teacher, will be guest lecturer at the Fifth Annual Desert Banquet of the Friends of Hebrew Culture on Wednesday, March 17, according to an announcement by Dr. M. S. Schulzinger, President of the organization. The Banquet will be held at the Avondale Synagogue Annex.
Dr. Halkin, who is Professor of Jewish History at the Jewish Theological Seminary and Instructor in Semitic Languages and Literature at Columbia University, is the author of numerous studies in both Hebrew and English.
