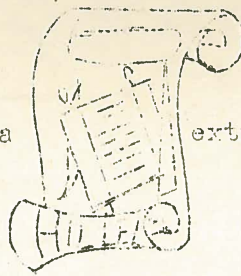

Sponsored by the Rabbinical Council of America, "Torah Tour" was undertaken to bring to the college student on his own campus the case for Orthodox Judaism in America, its history and its principles as a contribution to the spiritual life of the Jewish student at the American universities.

Participating in this "Torah Tour" are men who rank among the outstanding spokesmen for the Orthodox cause in America. These men are selected because they can present their point of view with the scholarship and erudition befitting a program designed to reach the campuses of the United States and Canada.

He is a past president of the Louisville Lodge No. 14 of B'nai B'rith.
