In a Nutshell

UC's Hillel is a completely student-run organization, open to any Jewish student on campus or at Hebrew Union College. Dues are \$3.00 for a full school year and are payable to the vice president, Allen Warth.

Every Jewish group in Cincinnati has at least one delegate to the adult Hillel Advisory Board. The Advisory Board meets every other month, and it is their job to keep the Hillel House in good repair and to see that policies set by National Hillel are fulfilled. Dr. Robert Kirsner, Hillel counselor; Mr. Joe Levine, assistant Hillel counselor; and Dotty Aberman, Hillel president, are also members of the Advisory Board.

All events and activities at Hillel are planned by the students. The Executive Board is made up of five officers, six main chairmen, and seven assisting chairmen. Following is a list of the offices and committees of Hillel along with their individual functions. Offices and Committees
