

**1966-67** Rented quarters obtained in order to meet increased demand.

**1967-68** Nursery program started to give children a head start in hearing education.

**1968-69** The University of the State of New York granted us a charter.

**1969-70** Acquired a building designed to meet our specific needs.

**1970-71** After burglary, re-equipped school with the most advanced electronic hearing devices.

**1971-72** Special infants' program providing a much needed early exposure to sound.

**1972-73** First Graduation—students integrated into regular Hebrew Day Schools.

**1973-74** Scientifically designed playground for development of motor coordination; EVALUATION and TESTING CENTER. . .

**1974-75** Opening new division for perceptual learning disabled children.

**1975-76** Building expansion to accommodate enlarged student body.
