A new Hanukkah musical comedy. The rabbi dreams of merging all holidays into ONE COMBINED CELEBRATION . . . and the pupils rebel to keep Hanukkah separate. Sophisticated script and songs. Ages: 9-13. Cast of 25 and up. 45 minutes.

An easy-to-produce musical comedy. (a two-note Purim Fiddler learns to play a REAL song after meeting the court musician in the palace of King Ahasuerus and Queen Esther.) Fun for actors and audience. Cast of 20 and up. Ages 9-13. 30 minutes.

Fresh PRIMARY GRADES Purim musical revue for presentation to school/congregation. Narration and eight original songs. Ideas for costuming and staging-rhythm band. Ages 3-8. 20-25 minutes.

THE FLAVOR OF THE SABBATH \$3.50

Cantata for PRIMARY GRADE narrators and chorus — 20 to 90 children. Delightful story about King Apetitus and his Friday night dinner invitations. Eight imaginative songs with Hebrew/English texts set the tone for introduction to and observance of Shabbat. 20-25 minutes.

Musical arrangement of famous folk-tale, told in narration and song. Excellent for Brotherhood occasions, Inter-faith groups, schools, centers and camps. Ages: 9-13. 25-30 minutes.

Based on the Bialik story "The Milk of the Lioness" this play is excellent for children of all faiths, and may be presented as a cantata with narrators and a chorus of 20 to 90 children. Optional use of slides or of children in costume to pantomime delightful characters. Ages: 5-8. 25-30 minutes.
