The Jewish Community Center is the home of the Jewish Community of Japan. It was founded in 1953 by the purchase of the present property by the Jewish Community of Japan which was originally organized in 1948 and incorporated in 1953.

The purpose of the center is to provide a center of Jewish life in Japan for its Jewish residents. First to educate Jewish children and give them a strong sense of Jewish identity and secondly to provide essential Jewish community services that are impossible on a private or family basis. In addition the center serves to provide a vigorous social life to strengthen the ties among Jewish residents of Japan.

Religious activities include regular Friday night services and Saturday morning services, plus observance of all major holidays.
