

8. Should a male member remarry, he shall pay \$_____ for securing a single grave for his new wife.

9. The graves shall be in rotation, from right to left.

10. Any member shall have the right to buy a lot in any part of the ground, the price for same to be fixed by the Chevra Kadisha.

11. Any member (he or she) after the death of either and they have purchased a lot, they must pay the balance on said lot.

12. Every member shall have the right to purchase a lot or single grave for his relatives, the price of same to be fixed by the Chevra Kadisha.

13. Every member using a grave must conform to the orthodox minhag for the Burial of the Dead.

14. After a member, male or female, has been buried in our cemetery, there must be left \$25.00 for a tombstone by the surviving members; said amount shall be held by the Cong. until the expiration of one year, and then a tombstone shall be put up or said amount returned, as the case may demand.

AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE X.

Section 9. In case of the death of a member, male or female, this Congregation shall furnish as follows: Warden services, grave (dug), hearse, one carriage for family and one for the officers of the Congregation to escort the body to cemetery, to good standing members only, the cost of same to be \$_____.

Section 10. At the death of children 18 years or under the following will be furnished: Warden and grave (dug), Only to good standing members, cost of same to be \$_____.
